Board of Directors Regular Meeting

St. Ambrose Episcopal Church

10 August 2015

Mark Johns called the meeting to order at 4:02 PM. Those in attendance were the board members Yvonne Gates and Bob Champ. Mary Wagner (Bookkeeper) and Peter O'Brien (Operator) were also present. Bill Hofgard and Rick Moeller (Directors) were absent (excused).

PUBLIC COMMENTS

No members of the public were present.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

The minutes of the 13 July 2015 meeting were discussed. Yvonne Gates made the motion that we approve the minutes of the 13 July 2015 meeting. Mark Johns seconded the motion, which was approved unanimously.

REPORTS FROM CONSULTANTS AND COMMITTEES

FINANCE REPORT

Mary Wagner had e-mailed the financial packet to the board (Balance Sheet, Income & Expense by month, P&L YTD comparison, Income & Expenses annual budget vs. YTD actual and the transaction report). Mary also e-mailed the water usage comparison spreadsheet.

Mary gave Pete a handout that Sensus had elucidating what they support with their maintenance contract. Pete will copy and forward a soft copy to Mark who will share with the board. Mary noted that the water leak fix on Spring Drive cost about \$11K. This will cause us to exceed the budget for this line item.

Mary went through the transactions and the financial statements and the board approved the transactions.

After Xcel was notified about high voltage spikes and started monitoring it, no faults have occurred. Peter noted that there was water seepage into the PRV pit. Mary will find out who constructed the pit so we may find out if they can do something about the seepage.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

BOOSTER PUMP CONTROLS

The Variable Frequency Drive (VFD) on the booster pump is now up and running. The district is now capable of delivering 300 to 400 gpm to the district. However, fire hydrants can still exceed our capacity so in these extreme circumstances water outages may still occur in the higher altitude portions of the district. The VFD also has stopped the water hammer noted prior to its installation.

GEN SET MAINTENANCE

It was decided that because there will be more usage of the Gen Set that we should go to an annual maintenance schedule. Peter noted that it is due for maintenance and he will handle the scheduling of the service.

NEW BUSINESS

COLORADO PRIMARY DRINKING WATER REGULATIONS

Mark had a handout for the board noting the revisions to the Regulations. Backflow Prevention and Cross-connection control notes that we must now develop written backflow prevention and cross-connection control program and an annual report.

There are also revisions to coliform testing, storage tank inspections and disinfectant concentration levels.

Peter will handle these revisions where possible and these revisions will be discussed further by the board.

BUDGET OFFICER APPOINTMENT

Mark Johns made the motion that we appoint Mary Wagner as our Budget Officer for the 2016 Budget. Yvonne Gates seconded the motion, which was approved unanimously. Mary noted that she would have a rough draft for the September meeting. The budget will be considered at the November meeting and finalized at the December meeting.

No comments were noted.

A motion was made to adjourn by Yvonne Gates, seconded by Mark Johns and unanimously approved. The meeting was adjourned at 5:44 PM.
