## Community Meeting

There will be a community meeting at 7:00 PM on Tuesday, November 28 in the Fellowship Hall at St. Ambrose. We will present the construction plans in detail, showing the route that the pipelines will take. Our engineer will be on hand to answer technical questions. Please take this opportunity to learn all about the construction.

We are tentatively planning two additional community meetings. One, during the winter, will present water-conservation tips and techniques. The other, during the early spring, will offer suggestions for connecting your house to the district system.

## Design Highlights

Here are few highlights of the design that is currently being bid on by contractors.

We plan to use existing meters and meter pits in Panorama Park. This will save considerable expense.

We will be using the Benchmark water main and the existing meters and pits in Benchmark. Again, we felt that the savings would be considerable.

We are trying to keep the mains out of the streets as much as possible, since every place we are in the street must be repaved at our expense. However, there are some places where existing trees and plantings meant going into the street.

## Non-Charter Taps

If you didn't sign up for the charter tap program, and you want to purchase a tap, the tap fee has been set at \$14,989 through December 22, 2000. After that, the fee will be set by the Board.

## Next Payment

The final tap fee payment, **due December 22**, will be \$5850.68 less any contribution credits. Invoices will be sent out in mid-November.
