Water is now available to every meter in the district. We realize there have been significant delays as well as tremendous inconvenience. You have all been wonderfully patient. Thank you.

Much Remains to Do

We have a rather long list of items remaining to be done, however. We have encouraged the contractor to focus on water delivery, so restoration and grading have received less attention. These will be our main focus until all items are complete.

Operations

The District has contracted with H.O. (Dick) Winters and Frank Hauke to tend to the pump station and mains of the district. They live in Panorama Park and were the operators of its water system since it was built.

Instead, please call our operators in the order listed at left. If both of them are unavailable please call a board member, also in the order listed at left. This procedure will help us get your problem solved more quickly.

System Damage

September Bill

The September bill will show a charge of \$6.50 plus per-gallon usage as follows

Up to 5,000	\$2.35/thousand
5,000 – 9,999	\$2.73/thousand
10,000 – 14,999	\$3.37/thousand
15,000 – 19,999	\$4.02/thousand
Beyond 20,000	\$5.10/thousand

In November, we will start using our "regular" monthly rate of \$40 (includes 5,000 gallons) instead of this temporary rate of \$6.50. We will also start assessing a standby fee of \$20 in November to lots with meters that have not yet connected.

Meters and Hydrants

The meters and hydrants should not be painted or adjusted without consent of the district. Please help us by making sure that the meters are accessible to the meter readers and that the hydrants are accessible to the fire department.

We will be testing the hydrants between now and mid-November at which point we will unwrap them and they will be "operational."
